TYPES OF SABBATICALS

- 10 years of service Professional Development
- Restoration to Health Please contact Health Services at 215-400-4660 for information
- 20 years of Continuous Service Only teachers and PFT secretaries are eligible

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

• Teachers, Principals, Secretaries, Nurses, Psychologists, Administrators

SALARY, BENEFITS, and RETIREMENT

- Receive 50% of your salary
- Contribute full retirement
- No change in medical benefits
- Q: What are the leave dates for sabbaticals 10 month employees?
- A: Fall Sabbaticals: August 16th to January 15th
 Spring Sabbaticals: January 16th to June 15th
 Restoration to Health Sabbaticals may begin at any time
- Q: What are the leave dates for sabbaticals 12 month employees?
- A: Fall Sabbaticals: July 1st to December 31st
 Spring Sabbaticals: January 1st to June 30th
 Restoration to Health Sabbaticals may begin at any time
- Q: When are applications accepted?
- A: Applications are accepted throughout the year.

Fall Sabbatical deadline is May 31st (date may change due to the school calendar) Spring Sabbatical deadline is November 30th Restoration to Health Sabbaticals – ongoing

- Q: Am I eligible to take a 20 year Continuous Service sabbatical after a PD sabbatical?
- A: Only if it has been 20 years since your Professional Development Sabbatical and so long as no other breaks in service has occurred.
- Q: If I choose a half-year sabbatical, how long do I have to complete the second half?
- A: You have two years to complete the sabbatical from when you started the first half.
- Q: When am I eligible to take another sabbatical?
- A: A sabbatical is allowed after each seven years of service.
